Paralympics 2024

In line with the Paris 2024 games, we had an inspiring topic: 'Beyond Limits, Exploring the Paralympics'. Children had a fantastic time learning about different Paralympians and inclusivity of sport. In sessions, children tried a range of sports - table tennis, badminton, and bowls.

Alongside a fantastic Summer party, Summer holiday club was another success, and children had a fantastic time creating arts & crafts, tie dying, ice lolly making and water bomb fighting as well as making new friends!

Plans for next year include inclusive holiday sessions welcoming siblings and bridging the long summer break for under-5s.



Service Highlights

Under-5s: Creativity and Growth

This year, our youngest learners explored topics like 'Step into Your Imagination' using Conductive Education techniques, storytelling, and rhythm-based activities. These sessions have helped children develop motor skills and discover the joy of learning through play. We started with 28 children, welcomed 9 more, and are excited for 2 new children joining us in January 2025.



5-12 years: Teamwork and Discovery

Our 'Beyond Limits, Exploring the Paralympics' theme inspired this age group, fostering teamwork and personal growth in small groups of 3-6 children. Starting with 25 children, we welcomed 3 new members during the year. Children eagerly set their own individual goals, working towards them with enthusiasm and determination.

Individual Progress

Every child received a personalised progress summary over the summer, reflecting their phenomenal achievements despite challenges like hospital surgeries.



Teens (12+): Independence and Connection

Our teens' programme continues to thrive, providing a space for social connection and skill-building outside of home and school. From cinema trips to bowling and a visit to London's Frameless Exhibition, teens embraced every opportunity to explore and connect. We've worked closely with families to plan for transitions like starting college, ensuring teens feel supported every step of the way.

Notably, the 12+ group have set the stage for more teen-focused initiatives for 2025. Looking ahead, we're planning more half-term outings to encourage independence and expand horizons.
